### The Fears of High-RAP Mixes

- Low end of PG grade will be lost
- Temp. cracking will increase
- Reduced life due to advanced aging
- Bumping may be needed to hold the PG grade
- Co\$t of binder may increase due to bumping or modifiers

- Determine the impact of batching on the low end grade of virgin binder.
- Compare PG Grade of virgin binder mixes with that of various RAP mixes.
- Evaluate impact trends of batching on low end of grade.




#### **Process**


# NHDOT and Pike laboratories ran duplicate samples for verification.


- Test virgin binders to confirm original PG Grades.
- Perform Extractions and Abson Recoveries on RAP samples.
  - Perform DSR, BBR and DTT tests.
- Evaluate low end PG Grades.

# Summary of Findings

- Virgin binder hardens by 1-2 degrees after batching. (CCT values increase numerically)
- Insignificant additional hardening in RAP mixes up to 25% RAP.
- PG Grade of RAP appears to have <u>little effect</u> on CTT.
